Engineer-Manager's Report – MDOT Mackinaw Road roundabouts will be starting – Three Mile Road from M-84 to Hotchkiss Phase I started 4/16; Hotchkiss to Midland Road Phase II; Public meeting was held on 4/16 – RTF 7B Mill and fills, May let – Doud Road August start date – Wilder Road rehabilitation delayed until 2025, bidding this year for next year construction – Seven Mile Road in Design Phase – Kaiser-Tower bridge pre-design completed by MTU students – NPDES permit is scheduled to be issued – Midland Road public meeting at Williams Hall next week – Countywide/Township paving starts end of April – Road bonding for Three Mile and Midland Road projects complete – recognized and commended Troy Houghtaling and Todd McLincha for 20 and 30+ years of service, respectively, at the BCRC and on their retirement.

General Superintendent's Report – Ditching – Prep for local road paving – Chip seal projects starting in May – Winter maintenance completed.

G. Augustyniak commended Todd for his service.

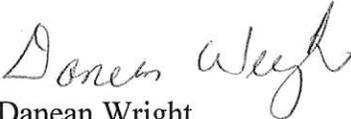
T. Spencer commended Jim & Cory for attending township meeting regarding Three Mile construction.
